 - b) To have RMA scheme be made online.
- 3. Ms. Anju Bajaj, National Secretary, Laghu Udyog Bharati suggested that Association's representative should accompany NSIC's official when they visit industrial area to inform the benefits and schemes of the Corporation amongst the members
