Issue of Tender Free of Cost 2. Exemption of payment of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) 3. In tender participation, MSEs quoting price within the price band of L1+15 percent shall also be allowed to supply a portion upto 25% of requirement by bringing down their price to L1 price where L1 is non MSEs. 4. Every Central Ministries / Departments / PSUs shall set an annual goal of minimum 25% of the total annual purchases of the products or services produced or rendered by MSEs. Out of annual requirement of 25% procurement from MSEs, 4% is earmarked for units owned by Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes & 3% for units owned by Women Entrepreneurs. 5. 358 items are reserved for exclusive purchase from MSEs.
